



## Suburb Profile

### North Fremantle 6159

**North Fremantle is bounded by the Indian Ocean to the west, the City of Fremantle/Town of Mosman Park boundary to the north, the Swan River to the east and Fremantle Harbour edge to the south.**

In 1856, the government advertised land for sale at North Fremantle but the area mainly developed following the opening of the railway from Perth to Fremantle in 1881. It was also an early industrial area, housing the Weeties Factory. North Fremantle was originally part of the Fremantle municipality, breaking away to become its own entity in 1895, but the two municipalities were united after an order from the governor in 1961 - history shows North Fremantle has been a quintessential part of the City of Fremantle.

North Fremantle has undergone significant change with residential developments at Leighton Beach, Rocky Bay and Northbank. A combination of cafes, antique and specialty stores in the strip style contribute to the atmosphere of a suburb with the beach on one side and the river on the other - the best of both worlds.
