



GUIDELINES for the INDUCTION INTO THE FREMANTLE SPORTING WALL OF FAME

1. AIM

- To honour, recognise and promote Fremantle's sporting heritage.

2. OBJECTIVES

- To induct sporting greats into the Fremantle Sporting Wall of Fame.
- To create a permanent display featuring the Wall of Fame inductees to be situated in a prominent position within the City
- To make use of Fremantle sports people, both past and present, to promote the City's involvement in sport

3 NOMINATIONS

- Nominations may be made by clubs, members of the Fremantle Sport and Recreation Advisory Committee (FS&RAC), community members and family members of the nominee.

4 ELIGIBILITY

- To be eligible the nominee must have achieved state, national or international representation and fulfilled a majority of the following criteria;
 - a. Outstanding sporting achievement at the highest level
 - b. Outstanding contribution to Fremantle sport administration, coaching or in a voluntary capacity
 - c. Involved in a Fremantle sporting club for a period of 5 years or longer.
 - d. The athlete must have retired from the highest level of competition for 5 years.

5 OTHER CONSIDERATIONS

- The nomination form that follows requires the nominator to provide a significant amount of information about the nominee. Please be thorough and accurate when doing this. The more information that is provided the easier it will be to make a complete assessment.
- All nominations will be assessed by a selection committee from the Fremantle Sport and Recreation Advisory Committee (FS&RAC) who will make the final decisions in the induction process.
